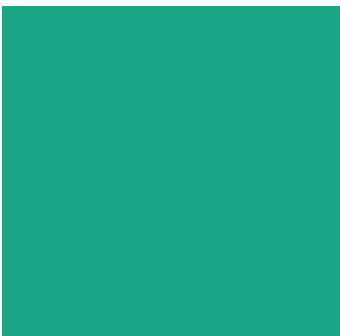


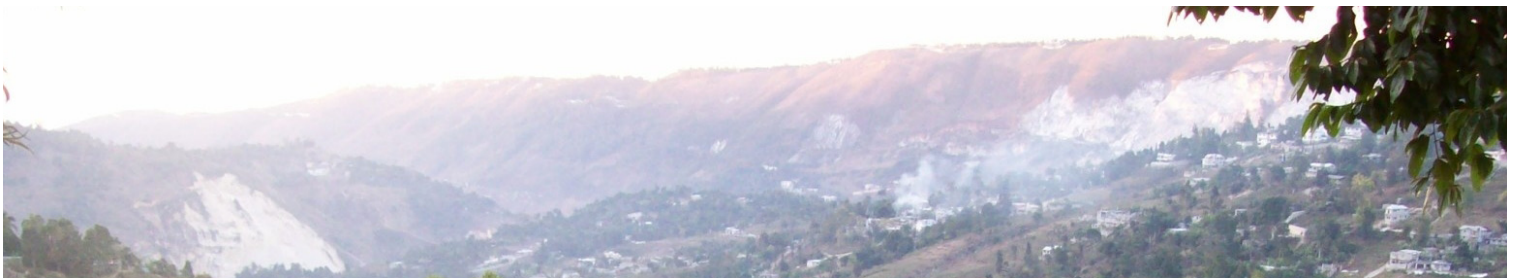

2009 marks an important beginning for Little by Little. Through our partnership with Mountain Top Ministries, Little by Little accomplished many great things in 2009:

In 2009 LBL ran two, week-long medical clinics, seeing over 2,000 patients in rural Haiti through the work of 40 volunteer missionaries

Of these patients, 800 were school age children, all receiving vitamins and basic primary care

Over 600 families were seen and treated at the MTM clinic

Patients were treated for gastrointestinal illness, skin infections, respiratory conditions, muscular/skeletal problems, and ear/nose/throat cases

LBL provided total annual operating funds for a orphanage in Port-au-Prince, where 11 orphans were provided a safe, clean and loving home environment

Over 50 pregnant and nursing women received pre-and postnatal care

In 2009, LBL gave out 1000 bags of medicated salt to combat lymphatic filariasis

In the area of Leogane, our funds to partner organization CNP provided over 20,000 childhood vaccines (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, tuberculosis, measles and rubella), with priority given to children ages six and younger.

**Dear Friends of Little by Little,**

As I sit to write this letter, I find myself reflecting on what an extraordinary milestone we reached this year. Consequently, I also find myself thinking of all the "little stones" that have paved the way for this moment. Stones have always been an apropos Haitian symbol to me. The Haitian side of the island of Hispainola is almost all rocky, mountainous terrain. These stones are a mixed blessing. They twist ankles when stepped on, they scrape elbows when fallen upon, and can become weapons when thrown. In the villages, farmers often harvest more rocks from the soil than vegetables. But, these stones can also be hand-pounded to create a crumble that makes bricks, building shelters against sun and rain. On the last day of our week-long medical clinics, team members always take home with them a stone from the mountain as a souvenir and a symbol their time in Haiti.

The year 2009 marks for us the beginning of Little by Little as a registered non-profit entity. It is because of you, committed friends, that we have been able to reach this important milestone and it is because of you that we have hopes for our future growth. Our passion for the people of Haiti and for faithfully partnering with those in need of improved health and well-being has been seen and heard by you! With your support, we will continue to produce impactful programs for years to come. We are proud to present to you our first annual report!

You have helped us to touch so many lives, truly paving the way for our future growth. The "stones" you laid in the time you volunteered for our missions, fund raised for donations, or prayed for our success are invaluable contributions. We look forward to growing with you, little by little, to reach our future milestones! Thank you for your accompaniment during this important year.

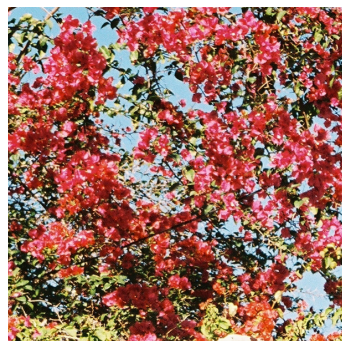
